Procedures

- Applications must be submitted with required documentation.
- All applications are reviewed by the Superintendent.
- Parents are required to meet with the building principal prior to registration.
- The principal will make the final decision whether to accept the student.
- Registration takes place.

To apply for Schools of Choice with Lake Shore Public Schools:

- Complete application form.
- Attach a current report card (not kindergarten applicants).
- Sign application.
- Provide proof of residency in Macomb County - 3 (three) pieces required (i.e. home purchase agreement, lease agreement, utility bill, cable bill, doctor statement).

Policy

It is the policy of the Lake Shore Board of Education that no person shall be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, gender, marital status, handicap, or disability.

- Once an applicant is accepted, he/she **will not be required** to apply annually.
- Applicants **must** be residents of Macomb County.
- Middle school and high school applicants must have Affirmation of Discipline form completed prior to registration.
- Application is valid only if it meets all requirements, is properly completed and signed.
- False information will void application and student's privilege to attend.
- The district is **not responsible** for transportation of Schools of Choice students.
- Students expelled or suspended in the past three years will not be admitted as Schools of Choice students.
