NORTH LAKE HIGH SCHOOL

Mission Statement

The mission of North Lake High School is to accept you with positive regard. You can expect respect, caring and trust. You can experience success and improve your skills in smaller classes with more individualized instruction. Our goal is to provide you with an opportunity to earn your high school diploma.

Who May Attend North Lake High School?

Students between the ages of 16-19 (students must have attained the age of 16 but be under 20 as of September 1st) are welcome to apply for admission to the program.

The North Lake High School program is designed for young adults who may have experienced difficulty or failure in a traditional high school program. Students are referred to the program by their home high school, the juvenile court system, or other agencies. Self-referrals are also welcome on a space-available basis.

On referral to North Lake High School, a student (and their parent/guardian) completes an application for admission. Then the student and parent/guardian participate in an intake interview to determine the student's goals and commitment to this alternative path to a high school diploma.

NORTH LAKE HIGH SCHOOL

Program Description

North Lake High School is in its 34th year of operation. It has gone by many names over the years: CEFOOSY, Born High School, Rainbow, Enterprise. North Lake High School is administered by St. Clair Shores Adult & Community Education and Lake Shore Public Schools serves as the fiscal agent.

During the 2006-2007 school year, students at North Lake High School attended school 1107.36 hours and 182 days. This year's alternative program was designed to accommodate 150 students, allowing for smaller and more individualized classes than most traditional high schools. All our students are full-time students and enroll in four (4) classes that meet five (5) days a week - Monday through Friday. The Friday classes are shortened blocks with an earlier dismissal time.

North Lake High School students may also earn credit for work experience and for taking the EDS test. All credit earned applies toward a high school diploma. Students must earn 20 credits to satisfy graduation requirements, if their original class has already graduated; otherwise up to 24 credits are required for graduation.

North Lake High School 2006-07 Points of Pride

North Lake students participated in the Macomb County Department of Human Services Easter/Spring Basket Project, the American Red Cross Blanket Days for the Homeless Campaign, the Macomb County Department of Human Services Canned Food Drive.

North Lake students won trophies in the following ALNET (Alternative Network) tournaments: Boys Basketball (Fall 2006), Euchre (Winter 2007).

North Lake students assisted St. Clair Shores Adult Education at the Fall Event, held October 14, 2006.
