What is Kids Against Hunger?

Kids Against Hunger (KAH) is a 501 (c) 3 nonprofit organization whose mission is to provide nutritional food to hungry and malnourished children around the corner and throughout the world. Over 20,000 children die daily due to hunger and hunger related diseases worldwide. Last year, KAH Satellites, nationwide, packaged over 60 million nutritional meals to help reduce the mega death rate resulting from the lack of nutritional food on a daily basis. The KAH motto is "when you feed a child you feed our future". The Kids Against Hunger Coalition is a Regional Division of the Kids Against Hunger International Organization headquartered in New Hope, Minnesota. The KAH Coalition coordinates mobile packaging events in the Great Lakes area. KAH Coalition Satellites along with nearly 100 Satellites throughout the United States and Canada are rapidly approaching the goal of packaging over 100 million nutritional meals on an annual basis. In recent years KAH Satellites have packaged and sent over 200 million meals to starving children around the corner and worldwide. In the next five years KAH Satellites have a goal of packaging over 200 million meals and ship them to over 100 countries on an annual basis. We are inviting volunteers and sponsors to partner with us in this humanitarian endeavor.

What is a Kids Against Hunger Event?

Kids Against Hunger Coalition sends out mobile packaging units with all of the materials (tables, bins, scoops, sealers, bags, etc.), ingredients, and managerial oversight necessary to complete a successful packaging event. The sponsor designates the location of the prescheduled event. The sponsor/s provides funding, a suitable location, and volunteers to complete a packaging event. One third of the meals can stay in the sponsor's local area to help feed starving children and families; another third is shipped impoverished areas internationally. The final third is stored and use for national disasters relief.
