For 2010-2011, Lake Shore High School made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

State law requires that we also report the following additional information:

#### **Process for Assigning Pupils to the School**

All resident Lake Shore students are assigned to a school based on the student's age, ability level, and residence location within the district. Resident students wishing to attend a school not within their residence boundaries have the option of requesting a transfer through the Office of Educational Services.

School of choice students are assigned to a school based on the student's age, ability level, and whenever possible, parent request.

#### **Status of the 3-5 Year School Improvement Plan**

Lake Shore High School is beginning its second year of the school improvement cycle with the 2011-12 school year.

#### **Core Curriculum Information**

Lake Shore teachers and administrators work closely with members of the Macomb Intermediate School District and follow the Michigan Merit Curriculum. Each grade level follows a scope and sequence that focuses on the high school content expectations provided by the State.

### **Aggregate Student Achievement Results for Local Assessments**

Each year all 10<sup>th</sup> grade Lake Shore High School students are assessed using the PLAN test. The results of these assessments help us determine whether students are achieving the benchmarks and give us information on how to change instructional practices in the future. In 2010-11 our students' average composite score was 16.9 on the PLAN assessment. In 2009-10 our average composite score was 16.7.

Lake Shore High School holds parent teacher conferences in both winter and spring each year. Below you will find required information on attendance at conferences.
