For 2010-11, Rodgers made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

State law requires that we also report the following additional information:

Process for Assigning Pupils to the School

All resident Lake Shore students are assigned to a school based on the student's age, ability level, and residence location within the district. Resident students wishing to attend a school not within their residence boundaries have the option of requesting a transfer through the Office of Educational Services.

School of choice students are assigned to a school based on the student's age, ability level, and whenever possible, parent request.

Status of the 3-5 Year School Improvement Plan

Rodgers Elementary is beginning its second year of a new school improvement cycle with the 2011-12 school year.

Core Curriculum Information

Lake Shore teachers and administrators work closely with members of the Macomb Intermediate School District and follow the State of Michigan Core Curriculum. Each grade level follows a scope and sequence that focuses on the grade level content expectations

provided by the State as well as the national common core curriculum adopted by the State of Michigan.

Aggregate Student Achievement Results for Local Assessments

Each year Lake Shore students are assessed in math, reading, and writing using local common assessments. The results of these assessments help us determine whether students are achieving the benchmarks and give us information on how to change instructional practices. Below are the average percentages of students at or below grade level according to these common assessments.
