

Recommended Supply List for First Graders



- 1 large backpack (preferably no wheels)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 green folder, 1 red folder, 1 blue folder, 1 orange folder, 1 yellow folder (the duotang folders with pockets)
- 1 box of dry erase markers for the individual white boards
- 1 box of magic markers (these will be collected and shared by the whole class)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 8 glue sticks (these will be collected and shared in class)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 container of Clorox/Lysol Wipes
- 1 activity book for your child to keep in their cubby to work on when time is permitted

**Some other items we will use throughout the year are: paper bags, plastic ware, paper plates, cups, napkins, etc. You may send those in if you wish or we will let you know when things arise.

Many activities in first grade revolve around working in cooperative learning groups. When school supplies are readily available the students are able to manage their time more efficiently. School supplies are easily mixed up between children, so we are asking you to **PLEASE** not send in any "special" items with your child. Items such as stamps, pens, fancy pencils, crayons, markers, folders, pencil sharpeners, etc., cause a lot of distraction for first graders, and often end up being sent home because of this. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Recommended Supply List for 2nd Graders

Dear Parents,

Here is a suggested supply list for second grade. By receiving the list early, you may be able to take advantage of the summer sales!

1 pack washable markers

4 glue sticks

1 yellow steno notebook -(50 to 100 pages only) wide ruled

4 basic two pocket folders **with fasteners** -(one each color – green, blue, red, yellow)

1 bottle antibacterial soap

Disinfecting wipes

2 boxes tissues

*Each child should have a backpack-no wheels please

Please DO NOT LABEL items with their name (other than the backpack.)

We could also use 1 gallon and sandwich size baggies if you see any good sales!

All supplies will be shared as common supplies and used in learning club teams at students' tables. We appreciate your support and look forward to an exciting 2nd grade year. ☺

Violet 3rd Grade Supply List

Listed below is a suggested supply list for third grade. We hope that in getting this to you early you will be able to "catch the sales" over the summer.

Please bring the following supplies on the first day of school: Please be sure to label all folders, notebooks, binders and personal supplies with child's name.

- **2- Blue 100 sheet** spiral bound notebooks- **WIDE RULED**
- **5 Duo-Tang Folders** with pockets and clips (red, blue, green, yellow, purple) * *the color is important for subjects*
- **1-2 Inch Binder/ 3 ring** (hard bound with front and back pockets)
- 1 package of **5 Binder Dividers with pockets**
- **4 LIQUID PENCILS** (erasable graphite ink, saves time and money of wood pencils)

at office supply stores or some drug stores

- lead pencils (no. 2)
- a good pencil sharpener
- crayons (**48 pack max**)
- colored pencils (**12 max**)
- markers-water based only (**12 max**)
- **4 high lighters**
- **4 Dry Erase Marker** (blue or black) clean, dark old sock for eraser
- scissors with long blade
- glue sticks (at least **10** to get through the year)-community supply
- 1 regular sized bottle liquid glue
- 1 clear ruler with American Standard and Metric
- small supply box only (Or Gallon Zip-Loc) desks are small
- **2 boxes of Tissue**
- **2 containers of disinfectant wipes**

Dear Fourth Grader and Parents,

Listed are suggested items that you will need for fourth grade. We hope that by getting this to you early, you will be able to "catch the sales" over the summer.

- 1 one inch, plain 3-ring binder (not the fancy, designer kind)
- pencils
- red checking pen or pencil
- hi-liter
- scissors
- crayons and/or markers (water based only)
- glue or 4 glue sticks
- ruler with American Standard and Metric measurement
- 2 boxes Kleenex
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- white board markers (basic 4 marker package)
- 1 or 2 packages of 3"x3" post-it notes (sticky notes)
- 5 spiral bound notebooks - 70 rule
- an egg of Silly Putty or a Kush ball or a Squishy ball (to keep idle hands busy)
- an activity book (i.e., coloring book, puzzle book, word search book)
- batteries (AAA, AA, D) for spell checkers, NEO's and science experiment)
- hand sanitizer

- 1 – Folder for Language Arts

- Crayons
- Colored pencils
- Markers – water based, NO PERMANENT!

- Handheld pencil sharpener
- Container for supplies
- 1 package of 3x5 index cards
- 1 protractor for Math
- 1 clean sock (used for dry erase boards)
